Please contact us about emergencies as early as possible. For **out of hours NHS dental treatment** when the surgery is closed call **NHS 111**. If you receive NHS dental treatment, please note that out of hours help is available from 9:00am - 10:00am on bank holidays and until 5:00pm on all other days.

If you are a registered private patient\* and have a dental emergency **outside of practice hours**, please telephone **01225 312 847** and our answerphone will give details of out of hours help. Please note the call out fee is £165 plus the cost of any treatment required. Alternatively, advice is also available by calling **NHS 111**.

## A dental emergency includes;

- Servere toothache or swelling that suggests an infection of a tooth or gum.
- Pain, which is not controlled by taking over-the-counter painkillers.
- Trauma of the face, mouth or teeth after a recent accident or injury.
- Loss of a permanent tooth.
- Bleeding after tooth extraction that you cannot control.
- Serious swelling of the mouth or face, which is getting worse.

**NOTE:** You should use the **NHS 111** service if you urgently need medical help or advice, but it's not a lifethreatening situation.

For immediate, life-threatening emergencies call 999.
